



Routes into Dalby Forest & Adderstone Field

Due to a large event taking place in Thornton-Le-Dale over the weekend we advise you to avoid that area as much as possible. We also have specific requests from the Forest Commission, that we need to adhere to enable continued use of the Forests for rallying.

Please help us to do this by following the below instructions.

Saturday 2nd November 2019

ALL RALLY TRAFFIC – Please approach Dalby from the Fox & Rabbit. From Pickering, take the roundabout (100/799838) up the A169 towards Whitby. In just over 4 miles, turn right at the Fox & Rabbit Inn (100/845882), and in 2 miles turn left into Dalby Forest (100/841851).

After the Toll Gates, follow the Dalby Forest Drive past the visitors centre, and all the way round to Adderstone Field. **DO NOT USE THE WORKSHOP ROAD.**

When leaving the Adderstone Field, turn left from the exit and at the Fire Tower crossroads (101/889.5890.5) and go straight on using the Eberston exit. **DO NOT USE THE WORKSHOP ROAD.**

Again, we suggest that you avoid Thornton-Le-Dale if possible, on your return route, however, later in the day it should be OK to travel straight through if you practice extreme caution and pass through slowly.

Sunday 3rd November 2019

ALL RALLY TRAFFIC – Before 8.15am please come into the forest via the Eberston (101/883898) entrance and the Fire Tower crossroads (101/889.5890.5). The gate at the crossroads will be locked at 8.30am. After 8.15am you will need to travel around the Dalby Forest Drive to gain access to service – No exceptions. **DO NOT USE THE WORKSHOP ROAD.**

Please note that there is an absolute ban on all vehicles other than stage traversing officials, competing cars and registered Auxiliary Cars using the Workshop road throughout the day. No exceptions.

To exit after the event, you will need to travel out via the Dalby Forest Drive. At the main road (100/841851) you may use which ever direction suits you best, however we ask that you take extreme care if exiting via the narrow junction at Thornton-Le-Dale – large vans and trailers will be better using the Fox & Rabbit (100/845882) way.
