This will be located in Ian Brown Tyres where scrutineering is being held. This will then be taken to the lunch halt and finally to the finish venue.

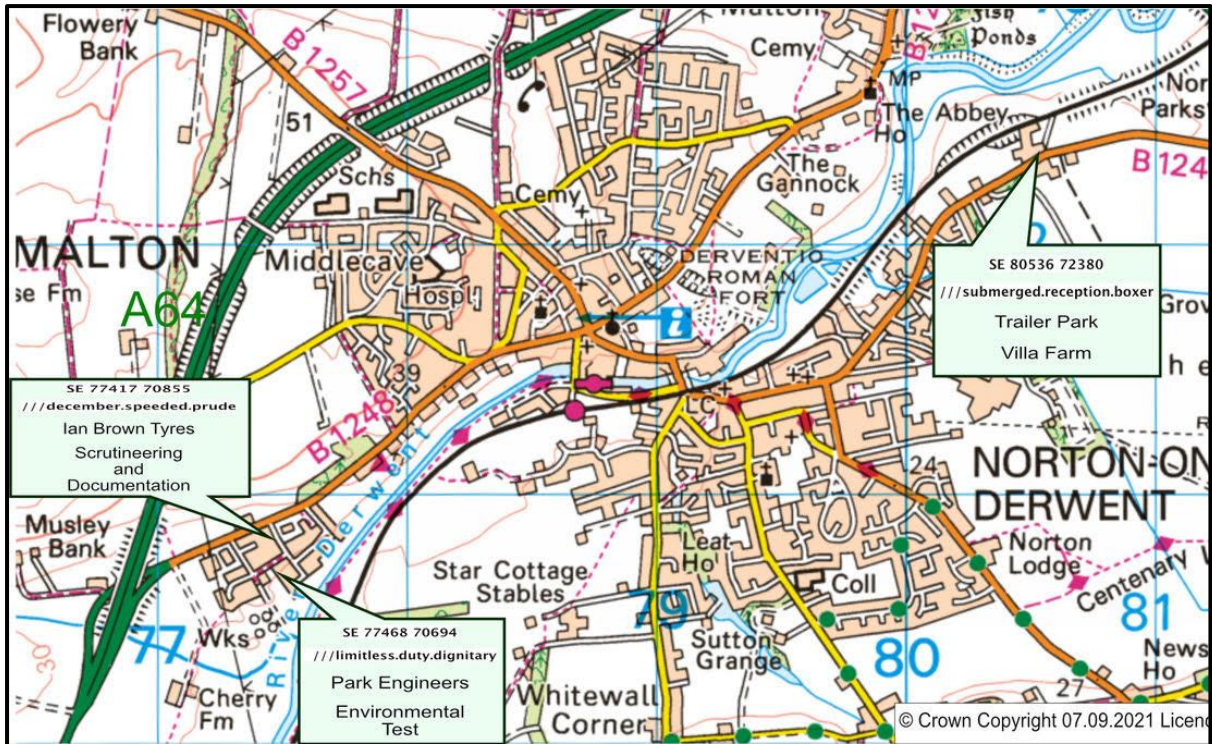
Trailers

On Sunday Morning, you should report to MTC0, which is in the same place as MTC1, to collect your road book.

You do not need to bring your car to MTC0, just walk up.

You are reminded of Section 170 of the Road Traffic Act 1988 and Rule 286 of the Highway Code. Any injury incidents must be reported to the Police Authority and the Clerk of the Course

Measured Distance

Start at 100/775715 at the 'DO COME AGAIN' sign depart WSW

0.00	Measured mile start sign
1.00	Measured mile end sign
1.28	Turn right road sign
2.09	Village sign Easthorpe
2.33	Take turn right signposted Amotherby
3.48	Stone built village sign Amotherby
3.53	Stop Sign Turn right onto B1257
3.90	Stone built sign Swinton
4.28	Take turn right signposted Castle Howard Short way round triangle
5.50	Give Way Sign – End of measured distance.

CONTROLS

Controls will be designated as follows

MTC these will be located at the following points

- MTC1 - start of the event
- MTC15 - end of test 5
- MTC16 - start of test 6
- MTC36 - end of the event

Competitors must start from MTC1 and MTC16 at their due time.

TEST PROCEDURE

Marshals will indicate when you should proceed from any box where you are required to stop for the time indicated.

Tests 3, 4 5,7,8,9 and 11 will start on part minutes.

The countdown will be 10. 5. 4. 3. 2. 1. GO.
